

## CLUB SANDWICHES, NOT SEALS: SAVING THE NORTHERN FUR SEAL IN THE EARLY 20TH CENTURY

Birders know the Pribilof Islands of Alaska for the chance to see Asian rarities, but there are more than birds on these remote islands.

In the 19th century, millions of North Pacific Fur Seals drew hunters who wanted to sell their rich fur coats. In this illustrated talk, **Kurk Dorsey** of the UNH History Department will explain how the United States led a four-nation movement to save the fur seals from extinction.

With colorful characters and deep splits about how to manage the seals, this is one of the most interesting success stories of international conservation.
