

White Mountain Forest Fires

Forest fires in the White Mountains are not common but under the right conditions occur and are often difficult to suppress.

In this program **David Govatski** will look at historic fires from the 1800's and early 1900's & more recent forest fires such as the Lucy Brook, Covered Bridge and Dilly Forest Fires.

Govatski will discuss the cooperative role of local, state and federal agencies after the passage of the Weeks Act in 1911 to work together on the forest fire menace. We will also consider the effects of forest fires in the ecosystem, prescribed burning, fire prevention and detection and fire weather.
