

The Remarkable Polar Bears of Churchill, Manitoba

Churchill, on the western shore of Hudson Bay, is perhaps the best place in the world to see Polar Bears up-close. The polar bears gather at the shoreline in October and November, to wait for the ice to freeze so that they can venture out to hunt for seals. Dozens of Polar Bears, plus Snowy Owls, Arctic Foxes, and Snow Buntings are part of the scene.

In this program **Bob Quinn** will share striking images of bears, foxes, Ptarmigan and even Northern Lights. He will weave in stories of the geology, marine habitats, as well as the early explorers and settlers of this unique, yet accessible, wildlife haven.
